

Net Zero Commitment

In alignment with efforts to limit global warming to 1.5°C as outlined in the Paris Agreement, Onnec is committed to achieving net-zero greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 2032. This goal is a vital step toward ensuring the long-term health of our business, our planet and the well-being of communities worldwide.

To meet this target, we will take the following actions:

- Reduce Emissions: We will implement energy efficiency measures, transition to renewable energy sources where possible, and optimise operations across our supply chain, reducing our GHG emissions by 62 % by 2031
- Carbon Neutral Operations: By 2032, we will achieve carbon neutrality by reducing our carbon footprint as much as possible and compensating for any remaining emissions through verified carbon offset programs and carbon removal projects
- Monitoring and Measuring: We will invest time and resources, building a team that supports low-carbon solutions and sustainable business practices in line with methodology consistent with the international standards BS EN ISO 14064-1 and The GHG Protocol.
- Transparent Reporting: We will regularly report on our progress toward meeting our 2030 net-zero target, following recognised frameworks such as the Greenhouse Gas Protocol and the Streamlined Energy and Carbon Reporting (SECR)
- Collaboration and Advocacy: We will collaborate with governments, businesses, and stakeholders to advocate for policies that support a global transition to a low-carbon economy and promote climate resilience. This applies to all customers and suppliers.

By taking these steps, we reaffirm our commitment to a sustainable future and demonstrate leadership in combating climate change in line with the global targets set by the Paris Agreement.
